Clarence Christmas Brunch Team

Led by the Salvation Army, and in partnership with Council and community volunteers, this group have met together for the past few months to put together a special Christmas meal for people in the community who may be keen to connect with new friends on Christmas Day. The group have been meeting, sourcing donations, planning menus and activities, and rounding up helpers, knowing that Christmas can be a time when some people can feel a bit low or isolated. Last year’s volunteers worked hard to provide a day that was very special, with many saying it was their “best Christmas ever.” Putting a smile on people’s faces this Christmas will make it all worthwhile for this group of helpers!

Soul Kitchen, Clarendon Vale

Starting around fifteen months ago, Soul Kitchen provides the community with a safe and sheltered place to eat. The kitchen is run by a group of local volunteers from the Abundant Life Church Men’s Group and the Clarendon Vale Neighbourhood Centre who enjoy helping people and providing support and love to the community. The volunteers work together to provide a free meal once a week on a Tuesday from 5.30-7pm at the Clarendon Vale Neighbourhood Centre, making a space to socialise, eat food and find out more about the community.
